

Ministerial Stipend Committee

The Ministerial Stipend Committee shall be comprised of four members of Presbytery, at least one of whom shall be a ruling elder. Members of the committee shall be appointed by the Presbytery to serve for a term of three years. The responsibilities of the ministerial stipend committee shall include:

- 1. To meet annually with each minister or licentiate laboring within the bounds of Presbytery to review the stipend paid to him and to discuss any problems arising from that level of stipend;**
- 2. To write to Deacons' Courts in the event that problems arise which appear to be requiring a solution;**
- 3. To notify the Presbytery annually that the committee has met with each minister.**
